- 4. Q: Please provide a list of special events referred to in Section 4.14 that will need to be serviced and the type of service.
 - A: These include, <u>but are NOT limited to</u>: St. Patrick's Day, Founder's Day, Movies/Concerts in the Park, Christmas Tree Lightning, etc.
- 5. Q: Please provide a list of Town locations to be serviced under Section 4.14 that includes the size, frequency & quantity of service to each.
 - A: 881 Senoia Road
 - 950 Senoia Road (New Town Hall Under Construction)
 - 945 Senoia Road
 - **143 Commerce Drive**
 - **145 Commerce Drive**
 - **Shamrock Park**
 - **Handley Park**
 - **Redwine Park**
 - These should all be weekly service.
- 6. Q: How many customers are currently receiving backdoor service?
 - A: We do not have an exact count, but it is a small number.
